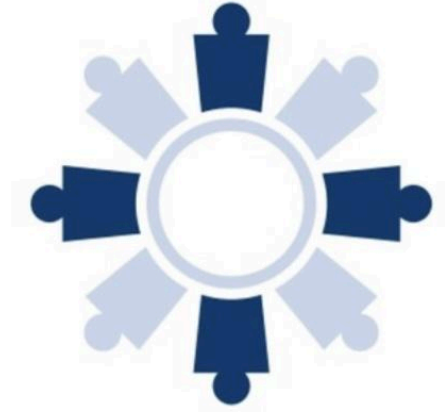

THURSDAY, MAY 2, 2024



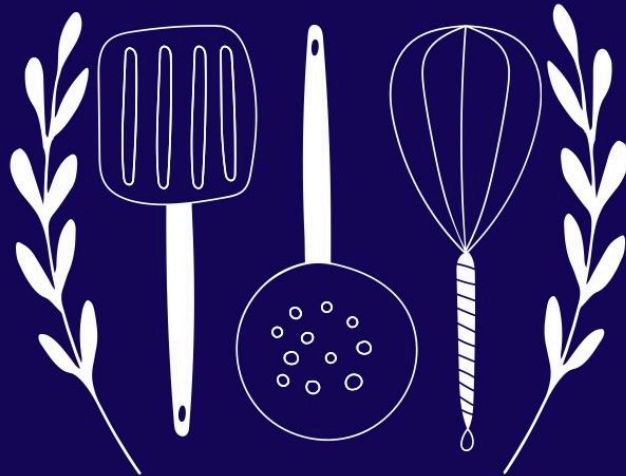

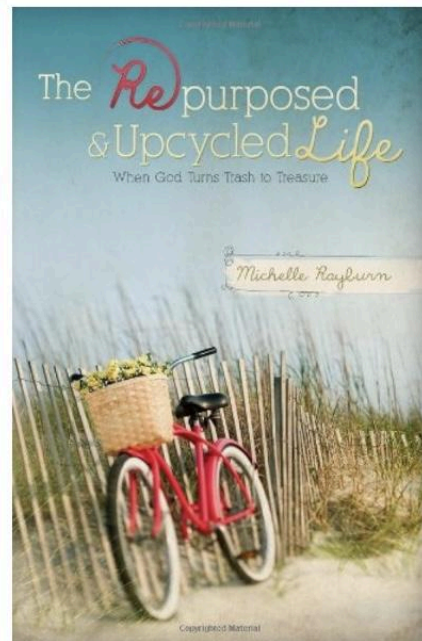

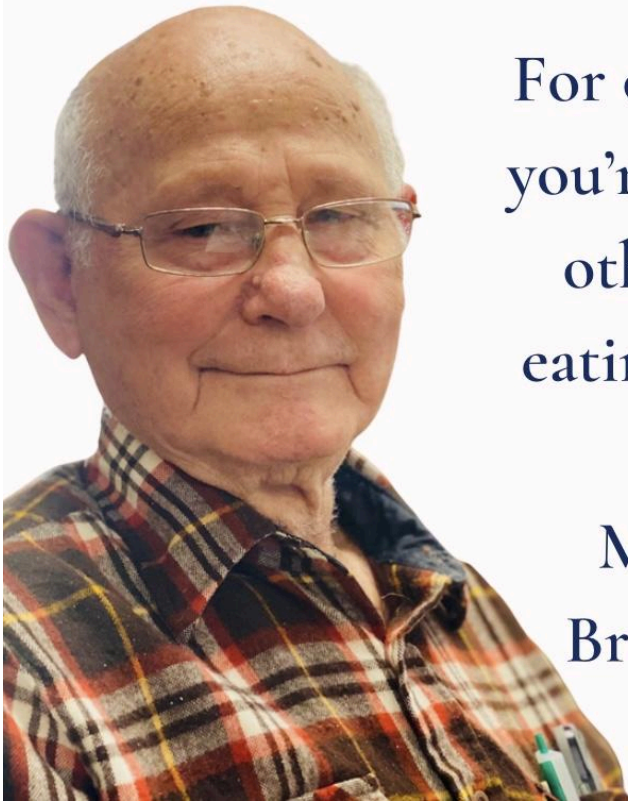
